- **Data management:** it is fundamental in MFIs to control and evaluate data quality and therefore, building strategy for a better financial inclusion.
- **Benefits from Cloud technology:** Technologies in microfinance should be considered as well and their importance is growing fast. Attend the class of a professional and founder of Open Bank Project.
- **Outcome and impact assessment:** MFIs have started to measure the impact of financial products on their clients' well-being and to improve their accountability to achieve financial sustainability and to promote learning and innovation. An effective impact tracking strategy must be adopted by MFIs. Practitioners and staff management of European MFIs
